- Graduating senior of an accredited high school or home school
- Candidates shall have a cumulative Grade Point Average of 3.0 or above
- Candidates shall be in the top 10% of high school class
- Scholarship funding will be applied to tuition, fees and books
- Candidates shall be United States Citizens and residents of the State of Nebraska
- Attend an accredited college or university in Nebraska
- Pursuing a degree in Engineering, Business or other degrees applicable in a manufacturing environment.
- Race, color, religion, age, gender, sexual orientation or national origin will not play a role in determining the recipient of the scholarship
- Financial need shall not be a criterion in making this award

Selection:

- The scholarship recipients will be selected by the Malcolm School Foundation with recommendations from Kawasaki Motors Manufacturing Corp., U.S.A.

Award

- In an effort to foster a relationship with students, Kawasaki would like the opportunity to meet the scholarship recipients, possibly present the scholarships and give the scholarship recipients a tour of Kawasaki.
