At the Board meeting last night—during the "Administrative Reports and Discussion" portion—multiple individuals said that they heard our construction project was way behind schedule. In fact, rumors have escalated to the point that some people think we will have a delayed start to the school year; break for summer sometime in June; and/or be forced to move Graduation. These comments came as quite a surprise to me considering we have a construction meeting every other week with the contractor, architect, owner's representative, and school administration. At these meetings, we are constantly updated on progress and timeline.

So—in an attempt to mitigate concerns, I would like to report that construction is progressing at a rate very close to pre-construction projections (give or take a few days). However, (at the risk of tempering optimism) we have a long way to go (relatively speaking) with plenty of time for setbacks. As of right now, our biggest concern is the timeliness of material deliveries. As one might expect, schools across the nation try to schedule building renovations and construction projects during the summer when students and staff are not on campus. Suppliers are under massive amounts of pressure trying fill all of the orders. I will say, our architect and general contractor are working every possible angle to get the materials here on time.

In closing, I would like to send a special thanks to our team: Byron Kringle—ConstructionSuperintendent (Hampton), Jason Hulsebus—Project Manager (Hampton), Cliff True—Architect (BCDM), Craig Vanderkolk—Owner's Representative, and all subcontractors and their crews. The team has really worked well together and seem to be a solution-oriented group. When issues have come up, they have worked a quick and suitable solution. Hopefully this continues through project completion.

***The program may employ a paraeducator who does not meet the twelve semester hour requirement as long as the paraeducator completes a minimum of six hours or the equivalent in training or experience within the first year of employment and meets the full twelve hour requirement before the end of the second year of employment.


