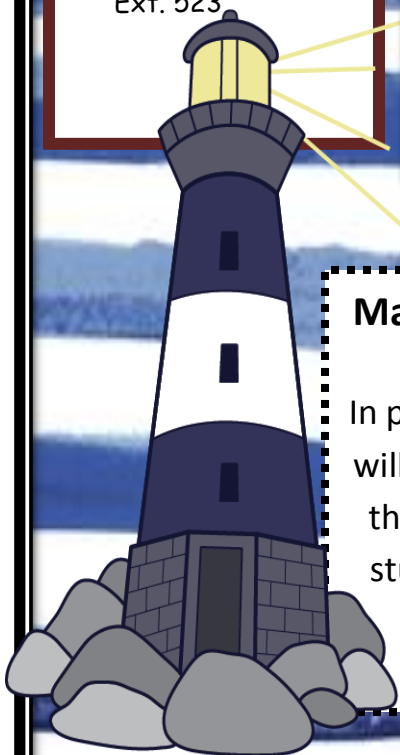
Malcolm Public School's Mission:

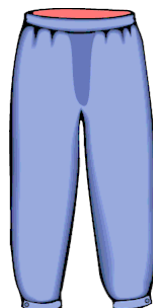
MPTO Fundraiser Kickoff Tuesday, February 20th
