- Tattoos



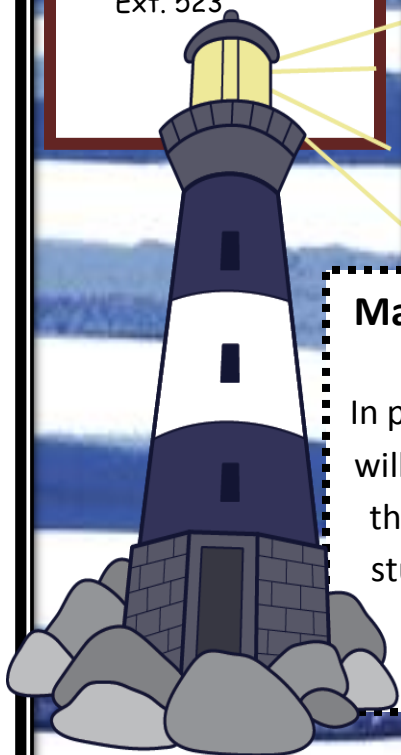
