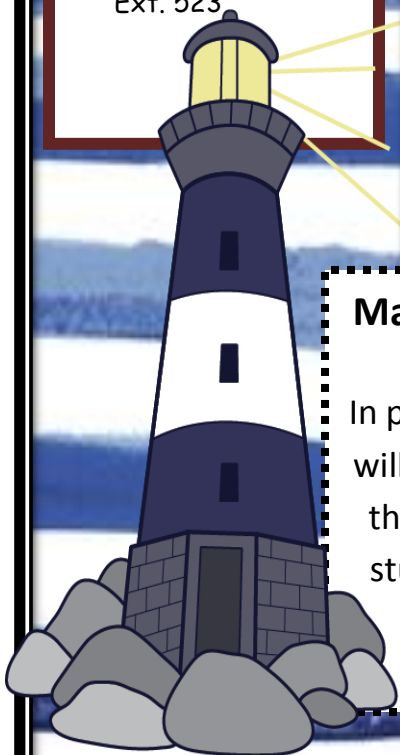

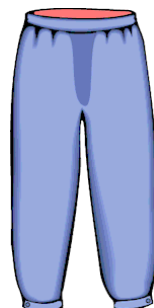
MPTO Fundraiser Kickoff Tuesday, February 20th
