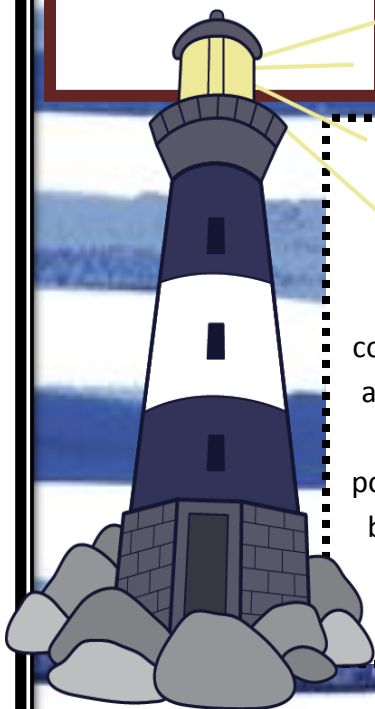
At the beginning of each school year, the students complete the DIBELS and NWEA MAP assessments. These assessments offer a snapshot of how your child is doing in the areas of math, reading, and science (science 4-11 only). DIBELS and NWEA MAP reports will be shared with you at conferences. It is a lot of information to take in so if you have questions please talk with your child's teacher or myself. These assessments are given 3 times a year and are used to monitor students as they progress through grade level skills. We will also use these assessments to guide interventions to students who may be struggling in academic areas.
