About Malcolm TeamMates:

- Any 3rd 10th grade student may participate in TeamMates and can self-nominate or be nominated by a caring adult.
- There will be weekly mentoring sessions that last around 30-40 minutes during the school year only.
- Mentoring occurs only at school either before, during, or immediately after normal school hours.
- Mentoring activities could include sharing a hobby or special interest, playing a board game, sharing thoughts or ideas, possibly helping with some homework, but mostly will involve listening and having face-to-face interactions.
