 - Play is work for young children and they learn best through direct experience
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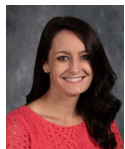
Curriculum/Assessment

Answers to Frequently Asked Questions



Where is the preschool located?

Malcolm Public Schools, 10000 NW 112th, Malcolm, NE 68402

How many days per week is preschool in session?

There are four full day sessions held Monday-Thursday during the school calendar year.

Classes are 8:30-2:30

Preschool will not be in session on ½ days of school or late starts

Who is eligible?

Malcolm Preschool is open to children who will be age 3 by July 31st and 4 year olds who are not age-eligible for kindergarten (age 5 by July 31st)

What is the cost for the preschool program?

Malcolm Public Schools Preschool adheres to the Rule 11 guidelines put forth by the Nebraska Department of Education to establish a fee schedule and guidelines for all preschool families. Within the framework, there are certain criteria for preschool fees:

- Meets one of the five criteria - \$0 per month
- Meets the Reduced Meal Eligibility - \$60 per month
- All other students - \$200 per month

Is financial aid available?

Children verified with a disability, born prematurely (36 weeks or less), children of teen parents, and children of families who demonstrate financial need are eligible for a fee waiver or reduced fees.

Are meals provided?

Breakfast, lunch, and snack are provided for all students. Lunch will be served "Family Style." This means preschoolers will be able to set the table, use child-sized serving utensils to serve themselves food, pass the dish to the classmates sitting next to them, and pour their own beverage from a child-sized pitcher.

- Breakfast is optional to all students for a daily price (prices subject to change):
 - Free Meal Eligibility - \$0
 - Reduced Meal Eligibility \$0.30
 - Full Meal Eligibility \$1.50
- Lunch is an additional cost (prices subject to change):
 - Free Meal Eligibility - \$0
 - Reduced Meal Eligibility \$0.40
 - Full Meal Eligibility \$2.55
- Snack is provided to all children and included in the monthly fee

Is transportation provided?

Transportation is offered to students who are verified with a disability. It is a possibility that transportation will be offered to students at dismissal of the preschool day for a fee.

Who are the teachers?

What is the teacher to child ratio?

Ten students to one adult, with a qualified paraeducator assisting as needed according to class size.

Is there a home-school outreach program?

Home visits are made at least two times per year. Parent-Teacher Conferences are also scheduled twice per year in the classroom.
