

## **Use of ESSER Funds**

### ESSER I: \$19,815

We paid for Covid Leave for Employees needing time off to deal with Covid related issues.

### ESSER II: \$75,502

As part of our mitigation plan, we purchased an abnormally high amount of custodial supplies: Disinfecting Chemicals, Masks, Gloves, Trash Can liners, Paper Towels, Spray Bottles, Hand Sanitizer, Hand Soap, Disinfecting Wipes, Air Filters, Disinfectant Supplies for Vehicles.

### ESSER III: \$169685

We plan to purchase classroom audio distribution (voice/sound field amplification) systems.

During the pandemic, we have noticed a need to update our teachers' computers to better handle remote instruction, as well as day-to-day tasks and in-class instruction. Due to updates in technology and additional wear-and-tear on our current machines, we will be replacing all of our teaching units with new laptops.

We are in the process of reviewing/piloting new English-Language Arts curriculum for K-12 grades. All of the instructional materials that we are reviewing are included on the Nebraska Instructional Materials Collaborative website. We plan to make a decision on the purchase this spring.
